Invite the neighbors for impromptu drinks

"Spontaneity makes a party fun," says event planner Yifat Oren, whose clients include Mariska Hargitay and Jason Bateman. ● E-mail your invite to about a dozen guests (enough to be festive but still manageable). ● Call it for 5 P.M. so people can make plans for afterward. ● Set up a self-serve bar of summery rosé (two to try: Solo Rosa 2006, \$15, and Château La Coste Coteaux d'Aix-en-Provence 2006, \$30). ● Serve easy, refreshing snacks: crunchy crudités on ice with blue-cheese dip; wedges of Parmesan or pecorino with grapes on a marble serving board (which will keep them cool).
